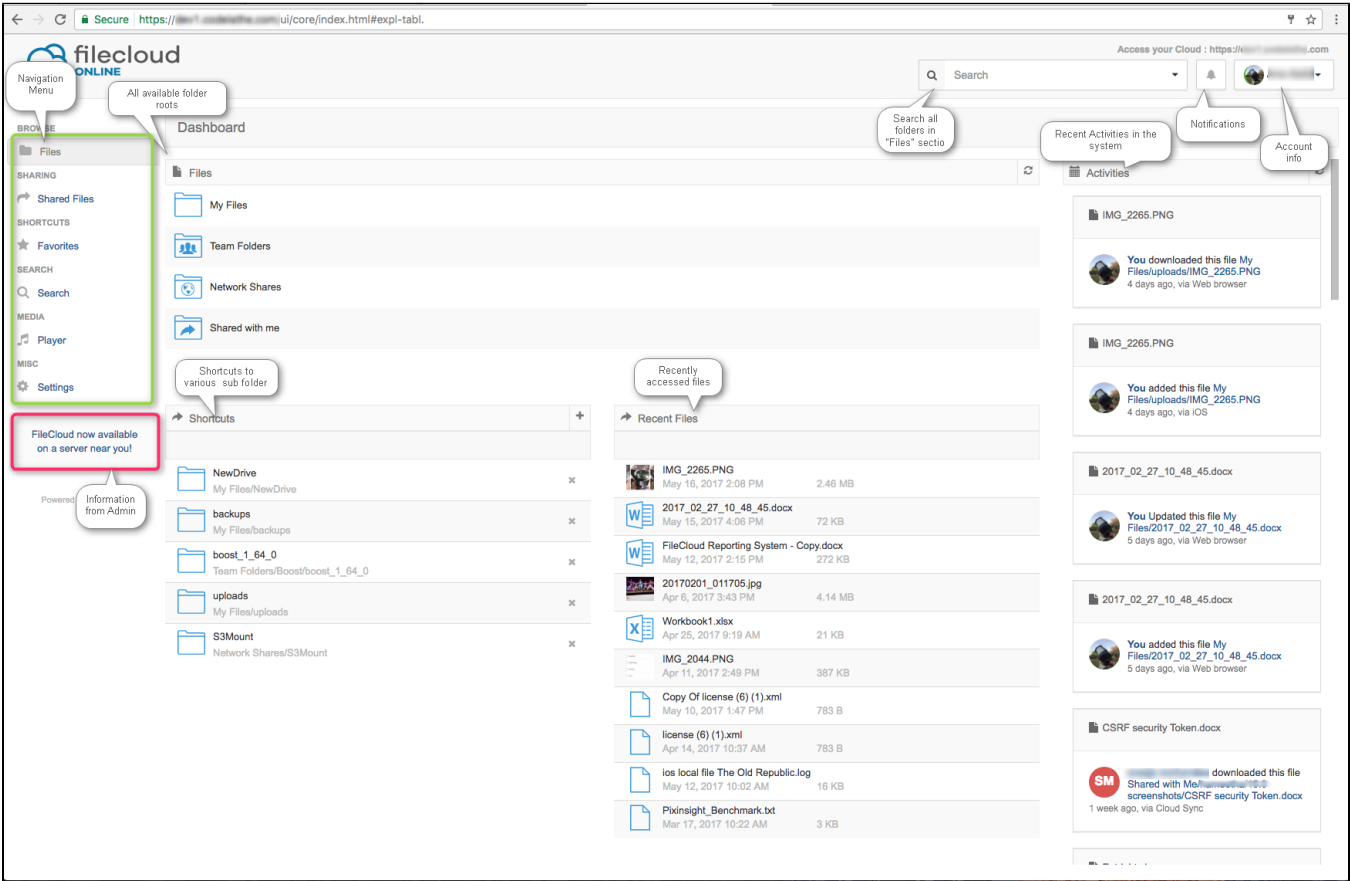
 The User dashboard is available in FileCloud Server version 15 and later.
