

Updating Tonido to Latest Version

On Mac OSX: To perform a Tonido Desktop update, you need to shut down the app and then move it from Applications to your Desktop, perform the full update (system and apps), shut it down again and then move it back into Applications and restart.

To Update Tonido Desktop to the latest version, go to Settings->General->Check for Updates.

After you click "Update", Tonido Desktop System will first update. After it completes, Tonido will automatically restart (on Windows and TonidoPlug). You need to restart Tonido for Linux and Mac OSX.

After you login via the web browser, you will get a prompt to update your applications to the new version, click OK, all the applications will get updated.
