- If you are using a TonidoPlug and want to access your files in your LAN, it is more efficient to connect to the USB drive as a network share. See [TonidoPlug: Access as a Drive](#)

Tonido software allows you to map your folders on remote machines as local drives allowing full drag-and-drop download, upload, in-place edit, rename, copy, paste, move and delete functionalities. Please note that this is only available if you have TonidoPro subscription.
